You may want to check these off as you put them into your suitcase. It is important to note that we are located in a very small village, there is no ATM within an hour's drive, no one accepts credit/debit cards. There is very little to purchase in our few tiendas, so it's important that you bring the items below and anything else you require with you. Please bring old clothes that you will not mind having soiled or possibly damaged.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING VALUABLE JEWELRY!

Should have-

8. Ear plugs to reduce the sound of roosters, dogs, waves and neighbors,

9. Insect repellent.

10. Camera with the CHARGER. Electric outlets are 110 same as the US/Canada. 11. Binoculars are great for whale, turtle and bird watching.

12. You will want shorts and light weight shirts or tank tops (built in bra for woman is great).

13. Lightweight long pants for hiking, horse rides and/or sun protection.

14. Sweat pants for sleeping, lounging and yoga.

15. Socks to wear with sneakers or boots for hiking, riding, etc.

16. Pajamas, nightgown or sweats and a t-shirt.

17. Bathing suit or shorts and tops you can swim in.

18. Sarong is handy for woman as swimsuit coverup evening wrap and other uses.

19. Wide brim hat or visor

20. Sweatshirt and/or poncho/ windbreaker (it is in the 60s at night).

21. Jeans

22. Sneakers

23. Rubber flip flops for beach and pool

24. Boots, can be short if you plan to ride or want extra protection in the goat pen or for longer hikes.

25. Bandana for dust, sun protection and variety of other uses

26 Biodegradable soaps and shampoos are greatly appreciated by our trees and plants..

27. If you are camping at the Ranch than you will want to bring your beach and bath towels, sleeping bag, pillow, etc.

We have plates, flatware and cooking utensils.

28. Small notebook and pens/pencils for keeping a journal or notes.

29. Advise your bank and credit card companies that you will be in Mexico.

30. There is cell service normally from the highest hill behind the bunk house. Internet is available at El Rinconcito a short walk away when it is actually running, service is extremely unreliable.

Most items are available in PV if your suitcase gets lost with the exception of a good head lamp and specific electronics, so I would bring those along with medications in a carry on.

If you are interested in visiting the local school let us know in advance so we can request the best day and time.***You may want to bring old clothes and/or school, supplies to donate.
